Dear Onondaga County Greenways and Blueways Community:

In recognition of the role that greenways and blueways play in our local economy, quality of life, and environmental health, I am pleased to share the Onondaga County Greenways and Blueways Grant Program. Onondaga County is seeking to partner with the local community to protect and expand greenways and blueways to provide unique recreation and ecological health opportunities.

Greenways and blueways are defined as corridors of open space or waterways that incorporate diverse natural, cultural, and scenic features. Speciftically:

- Blueways are a navigable water body which creates the opportunity for recreational water routes.
- Conservation greenways protect natural resources by conserving natural corridors and sensitive ecosystems,
 protecting watersheds, and preserving scenic resources including views of farmland.
- Recreation greenways are established for public recreation, providing opportunities to interact with the natural
 environment and spend time outdoors.

These grants may be used to cover a variety of projects to grow and enhance greenway and blueway systems. Funds may be used for projects or programs such as greenways and blueways plans for your community, installing, expanding or diversifying greenways and blueways, improving safety and ease of access, or adding new programming. Applicants are encouraged to be creative. Your submissions will help us to know what your needs, and the needs of the local community are. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis, until funds run out. The maximum award per project is \$50,000, unless the project is of regional significance to the community and its residents for which the maximum award is \$150,000. There is a minimum 20 percent local match on each award.



•	gible Project Types: Conservation Greenway/Blueway: Funds may be utilized for projects that protect and enhance natural resources, preserve wildlife and plant species, provide for habitat restoration of areas, water quality improvements, and prevent habitat fragmentation. Conservation Greenways do not have a robust public recreation element built into them as they are meant more to protect the ecological assets of the Greenway. The funds may be used for, among other things, land acquisition, habitat restoration, water/soil quality improvements, education and programming and similar projects, that seek to protect the well-being and raise awareness of the Conservation Greenway.					
•	Recreation Greenway/Blueway: Funds may be utilized for projects that provide opportunities for public recreation and access to allow for interaction with the natural environment, including trails for transportation and recreation. Funds may also be used for acquisition, land or water-based trail development, infrastructure improvements that enhances public access (including ADA accessibility), connectivity, safety, planning, design, maintenance, and signage and wayfinding.

There is a minimum of a twenty (20) percent match requirement on each award. Projects must be completed in no more than eighteen (18) months.

Applicants are encouraged to submit any additional materials as part of the submission process. Such materials may include but are not limited to:

- Any plans or renderings, if available
- Map detailing the site's location and Tax ID's
- Photos

Applicants from NFP entities must submit documentation showing support from the local municipality(ies) where the project is proposed. Please attach a letter from support from the municipality(ies).

Onondaga County reserves the right to request further documentation and/or clarification as part of application review. Failure to provide the information requested on a timely basis may delay the review process and/or awards. The applicant, if awarded funding, shall adhere to the Standard Terms and Clauses for Onondaga County contained in the grant disbursement agreement.

Awardees will enter into agreement with Onondaga County and be expected to provide required reporting and documentation of work performed to the Onondaga County Department of Planning, to ensure consistency with the approved application details and scope. Further details will be provided upon award.

Any work that will be completed on private land will require an easement or other legal right of public access prior to the work being performed to guarantee that the property will be able to be used as part of a greenway/blueway in perpetuity.
